Building our Creative Economy:

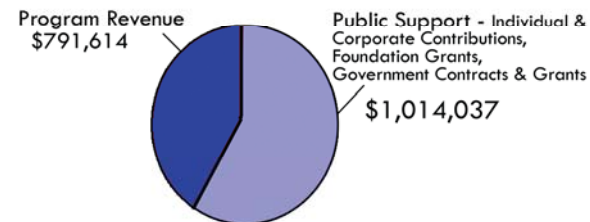

FY10 REVENUE

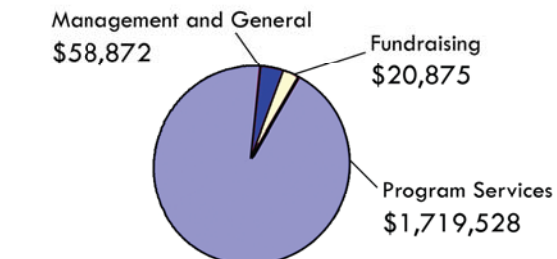


Total Operations Revenue: \$1,805,651

DAC achieved a 6.2% increase in program revenue this year.
