Encaustic

This one-day encaustic workshop is specifically designed for teens. Teens absolutely love learning the process of encaustic painting, and will have 1-2 completed art pieces at the end of the 5-hour workshop. Hands-on learning includes painting, glazing, texturizing, layering, collaging and fusing wax with safety-rated torches, craypens and specialty irons. Safety comes first, and the DAC studio is well-ventilated for encaustic. Students will learn proper care for encaustic pieces, and proper techniques for ensuring work is archival. Weave It Wild Workshop! Woven Skeletons for Halloween and Day of Dead Dioramas (Ages 10 & up)

Interested in weaving but don't know where to start? Come downtown to learn about fiber, knots and weaving on a loom made from household materials. We will explore the interplay of color and texture by weaving in colorful yarn scraps, natural fibers and unusual materials as we create skeletons. Learn about warp-faced weave structures while you make a 7" soft skeleton with a pompom head and glowing eyes. Resulting skeleton will be lightweight, flexible and suitable as wearable or hanging structure to pose in your diorama. A \$5 materials fee is due to instructor for loom materials. An additional optional \$5 materials fee is due to instructor to add glowing eyes to your work.
