Precious Metal Clay is an exciting material where microscopic particles of silver are mixed with a moist binder to create a material that has the feel and working properties of modeling clay. Using simple tools, objects are easily given shape, texture, and character. After air-drying, the objects are fired in a kiln and you are left with pure silver that can be polished, soldered, enameled, and enjoyed like any other silver item.
