Scholarship Information

Durham Arts Council awards scholarships on the basis of financial need. Scholarships are awarded through a formal application process, and DAC offers scholarships to children and teens for up to 75% of the cost of the camp. The awards are made based upon the financial need of the child/teen's family. A scholarship application should be completed and attached to the camp registration form. ONE WEEK MINI CAMPS

Mini Camps are designed to fill the time right after and right before the start of school for year-round and traditional school year students. Students are divided into age appropriate groups and participate in both visual and performing arts activities that are inspired by a weekly theme. **DAC provides a fresh fruit snack. If your camper has food allergies to fruit, please pack a snack. Please pack your campers a brown bag lunch (no refrigerator or microwave available).**

Mini Camp 1: Recycled Art

June 11-15

Create art by reusing what most people use once and then throw away. Bryant Holsenbeck and David Edgar are just two of the many artists that create from recycled materials. Get inspired by the various artists and organizations in North Carolina that work with and support the use of recycled material to create your own recycled art.

TWO WEEK CULTURAL ARTS CAMPS
June 18 - August 10

Your camper will take a journey across the globe during Cultural Camp. Each two-week session is a fun and in-depth exploration of the arts and culture of a country. Depending on age and interest, student will choose a performing or visual arts track. Each two week session culminates in camp exhibition and performance on the last Friday at 12:30pm.

Cultural Camps run from 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM with early drop off beginning at 8:00 AM. DAC provides a fresh fruit snack. If your camper has food allergies to fruit, please pack a snack. Please pack your campers a brown bag lunch (no refrigerator or microwave available).

Afternoon Adventures complement activities campers have worked on during the day, and includes visits by extra special artists and performers as well as fieldtrips to fun cultural destinations.

For Cultural Camps, choose your arts track based on the campers age and interest.

Age 5 & 6: Creative Kids - For Rising Kindergartener and 6 year olds, this camp offers storytelling, dance, music and fun age appropriate art activities for our youngest campers.

For ages 7/8, 9/10 & 11-13 - Choose between visual or performing arts track.

Session A: Festive Philippines!

The Philippines, an archipelago located in Asia, consists of over 7,000 islands. While many Filipinos come from the Malay race the culture is a melting pot with Chinese, Indonesian, and Arab influences. Spanish colonization in the 1500's brought change in religion as well as architectural changes to the area by creating walled cities called Intramuros with churches and other buildings inside. In 1898 the Philippines became the first American colony and experienced more outside influence as changes were made to language and education. Come take a peek inside this exciting country.

You will receive a refund, less \$30 service charge per two-week camp per session and \$10 per mini-camp session. These are the only circumstances in which DAC gives cash refunds. DAC will transfer your child to a later session only if space is available. Parents who need to withdraw their child/children from any Summer or Intersession Arts Camp, for any reason, after the start date should contact DAC Education Office in writing. You will not receive a cash refund. You may transfer your remaining balance to another camp or course in the same term for any family member.
