Figure Drawing (Ages 16 & up)

This class combines practice and personal expression with instruction and critique. Students sketch from a live, nude model in short poses (a few seconds to a few minutes) and long poses (up to 30 minutes). Lessons focus on specific skills: process, gesture, shading, mark-making, proportion, anatomy and composition. Each lesson begins with examples, demos and group instruction and includes guided practice, individual and group critique. For homework, students study and copy the master drawings provided. Basic drawing skills are needed for this course. Please check the DAC website for supply list. Students under 18 must provide a signed permission letter from a parent or guardian.
